**Telephone:** Answering the Koala rescue mobile phone (so can be answered from anywhere), ascertain whether a rescue needs to take place, calling rescuers to attend and ambulance if needed, dealing with enquiries, following up on call outs and keeping telephone/rescue log up to date. (Full Training Will Be Given).

**Fund Raising and Publicity:** Collecting Money tins, setting up promotional stalls and operating stalls, organising ways of raising money for the group, talking to the public including schools or social organisations. (You would not be required to do everything listed - please cross off areas you would not want to be involved in).

**Administration:** Organising rotas, typing up documents, web site, statistics, newsletters, sending emails, press information, power point presentations, Compiling training documents. (You would not be required to do everything listed - please cross off areas you would not want to be involved in).

**Leaf Collecting and Koala Surveillance:** Collecting Koala Food Leaves for our Carers, carrying out on foot searches of designated areas to see if there are Koalas present, monitoring of known Koala habitat.

**Carer:** Looking after Sick, Injured or Orphaned Koalas until they are able to be released back into the wild. (Full Training Will Be Given).
